

- 1) At 18 feet long, this Harley Earl designed luxury 1947 Cadillac Series 62 convertible is an impressive and glamorous looking vehicle as it travels down the road.
- 2) As a passenger in this 4,450 pound car with a 129 inch wheelbase, the ride is very comfortable and relatively quiet. The luxurious interior (by Fleetwood) features "Hydro-Lectric" power window lifts, power seats, power convertible top and full leather upholstery.
- 3) The 346 cubic inch "L-head" V-8 engine, rated at 150 horsepower at 3,600 rpm, comes with a two barrel carburetor. The engine compartment is stock except for the addition of a modern air conditioning compressor. The fully automatic 3 speed "Hydra-Matic Tranny" moves this Fisher bodied car down the road effortlessly.
- **4)** The hidden fuel filler cap for the 20 gallon gas tank is located under the left rear tail light.
- 5) A custom built center console (styled to match the interior) houses the three modern air conditioning vents, temperature gauge, power outlet and modern stereo with speakers.













#### **AUTOMOTIVE LOGOS REVEALED**

#### Cadillac Emblem and Wreath

When William H. Murphy and Henry M. Leland founded the Cadillac Motor Co. in 1902, they paid homage to the man who founded the Motor City: Antoine Laumet de La Mothe, sieur de Cadillac, a FrenchexplorerwhoestablishedFortPontchartrain

du Détroit. Not only did Leland and Murphy use Cadillac's name, they used the man's coat of arms as well, registering the emblem as a trademark in 1906. While the modern version incorporates



wreaths and a clean, linear design, the original badge was based on a literal version of de Cadillac's badge, including the two sets of three merlettes (ducks, basically) to represent the Holy Trinity, and a nine-pointed crown on top, representing the ancient counts of France.
