

A caravan of six vehicles and eleven Florida Region AACA members were guests of Alan Stone, President of the The Villages Region AACA. Tom Holt was our event organizer. As guests of the Villages AACA, our group was given premium parking spots since we wanted to park together as a group. We were allowed into the cruise area 15 minutes before it opened to the general public at 3 pm. Our six cars parked near a shady area near a restaurant with overhead fans and close bathrooms. The weather was in the 80's and clear with cool breezes towards the end of the day.



Our car group consisted of Tom and Dena Holt (1950 Oldsmobile 88 Hardtop), Ray Eckhart (1953 Ford F-100 Pickup), Larry Cole (1990 Cadillac D'elegance) with David Main, Michael and Diane Montague, Bob McMullen (1953 Oldsmobile Super 88 Four Door) with Terry Firestone, Don Allen (1955 Chevrolet Bel Air Two Door Hardtop) and myself (1966 Ford Mustang).

Most of the cars at this cruise were hot rods (modified engines). There were some Model A's and Brass Era cars but the most interesting car there was a **1937 Packard** that was a daily driver! The owner uses the maroon Packard for his realty business to carry clients around the area. He admitted that with no air conditioning, the car will be used less in the hot Florida summer months. As a northern car, this car featured a 6 inch square metal grate on the backseat floorboard for the backseat heater. He mentioned the banjo steering wheel was a \$3 option in 1937. *FYI: The Villages Car Cruise is held the 3rd Saturday of the month.*

1) The clean engine compartment is just as it looked in 1955. This was GM's first successful Chevy V-8 engine. The 265 cubic inch engine (162 horsepower, 4.3 Liter) with 2-barrel carburetor is stock. The engine has no power accessories. The engine came stock with no oil filter! The automatic transmission is a 2-speed Powerglide. Don uses a "tar top" 12 volt battery when at judged car shows. All the date codes tie in with the build sheet of June 1955.


2) Don bought the car in 1984. It was a daily driver until he decided to restore it completely. The full restoration was completed in 1990. Don did all the restoration work himself except for the drivetrain, paint and body work. He redid the interior (with his mother-in-law's help). The interior features the factory push button radio and deluxe heater.

3) Lots of chrome! The car oozes crisp and clean styling. The front grille evokes a Ferrari style grille.

4) The stock colors are India Ivory and Black. Front and rear bumpers feature optional "fender guards".

5) This full size car rides on a 115 inch wheelbase with bias ply reproduction tires all around. The car has great visibility and starts right up. Don has put over 31,000 miles on the car and has driven it to many National meets, shows and AACA Tours.


