



### **1929 LaSalle Convertible Coupe**

*Sold for \$110,000,* Lot #1369



"This (2008 AACA Senior and) concours winning **LaSalle** is equipped with a V–8 power plant, 3-speed synchromesh transmission, wire wheels, dual side mount spare tires, Pilot Ray driving light, radiator stone guard, rumble seat, rear mounted trunk and golf bag door".

#### 1955 Mercedes–Benz 300SL Gullwing Coupe

Sold for \$2,090,000, Lot #5044 Bought new in California. The third owner had it for 53 years until selling it 3 years ago. 72,000 original miles. Restoration finished last year. "This **300SL** is equipped with all matching numbers (engine, chassis, body, transmission, rear end and front axles) and its original 3-piece belly pans".

## 1972 Volkswagen Karmann Ghia Convertible

**Owners**:

1) The Pyle's purchased this car at the November Daytona Turkey Run several years ago in its present condition. The curvaceous car body was designed by *carrozzeria* Ghia in Turin, Italy and the coachwork was hand built by the renowned German firm Karmann. Almost half a million Ghia's were made over its production lifetime with only 80,837 of them built as convertibles. Karmann Ghias were made between 1955 and 1974.

2) The 4 cylinder, 1.6 liter (97 cubic inch) air cooled engine developed 60 horsepower from the factory. This engine was upgraded by the previous owner with some shiny chrome parts. The aftermarket aluminum diamond plate panels were added to "doll up" the engine compartment. The engine's battery is located behind the left side panel.

3) The interior remains stock except for an upgraded 4 speed shifter handle. The "heater" for this car is derived from ducting coming from the engine's heat shroud.

4) The carpeted front compartment has the gasoline tank and storage area. The hose coming off the spare tire was used from the factory to power the windshield washers.

5) Bill and JoAnn enjoy taking their "cute" orange convertible out on sunny days. The clutch pedal is easy to operate. Since the car is so light and low, the car really "scoots" and feels really nimble. Wind noise is not too bad with the convertible top down.











## Sold On eBay

This **1936 DeSoto Airflow S2 Sedan** sold on eBay for \$15,600. Only 4,790 Airflows were made in 1936. It is powered by a 241 cubic inch (3.9 liter) inline flathead 6 cylinder engine making 100 HP @ 3,400 rpms. Claimed to be the first *American* built unibody.
