

This **1956 Chrysler Windsor 2 Door Hardtop** sold on July 12, 2014 on eBay for \$7,885.00 (after 21 bids).



From the seller's description...

"For 1956, the "Forward Look" styling was introduced by Virgil Exner, Chrysler's famous automobile stylist. The first tail fins on a Chrysler

appeared. The 331 "Spitfire" V8 is original to the car as well as the push button automatic transmission. This car has all of it's original body panels. Starts right up and runs and drives very well. Horn, lights, and signals all work. Gauges all work. Radio does not. Very rare car. When is the last time you have seen one? California car. The car was stored inside for many years, so when I purchased the car 3 years ago I had to send the gas tank out to have it restored, cleaned out the fuel lines and the carburetor. I purchased a new battery and it started right up. It runs and drives great. I have driven it about 50 miles since. Chrome is all original and nice. Stainless steel trim is like new. Passenger side door glass has a crack. All other glass is good. Clean California title with current registration. Some rust bubbles in the outer rocker panels and bottom of fenders. No rust in the frame."

1959 Cadillac Coupe deVille 2 door

- 1) The Cole's bought this car in 2011 from a car collector in the Tarpon Springs area (near Tampa) in its present condition. The Cole's have replated some chrome pieces but otherwise the car is unrestored. The rear tail fins are the tallest that Cadillac ever made. The tops of the fins stand 44 inches off the ground! The twin bullet rear stop lights were inspired by jet fighters from the 1950's. The base price for this Series 63 Cadillac was \$4,810 in 1959.
- 2) The 390 cubic inch (6.4 liter) V–8 engine with a four barrel Carter carburetor was rated at 328 horsepower @ 4,800 rpms and torque of 430 @ 3,100 rpms. The engine features a new model air conditioning compressor as the only upgrade to the 1959 engine bay.
- 3) The interior features power steering, power windows, power locks, power brakes and power seats. The Hydra Matic 4 speed automatic transmission is shifted on the steering column. The interior bench seat has white leather trim with dark gray fabric with silver metallic threads. Outside visibility is excellent in this car.
- 4) The car rides on modern P235/75R-15 radial tires with 1959 El Dorado hub caps. The entire car was repainted this year in Cadillac white with a gray silver metallic color on the roof section.
- 5) The Cole's drive this car to local car events. With a wheelbase of 130 inches, a weight of 4,720 pounds and a length of 225 inches this car rides very smoothly.

Claimed to have 91,400 original miles.

From the seller's description...

"Engine: 8 Cylinder 248 cubic inch Special B-Series with Dual Carburetion (Only Production Year Buick Ever Offered Multiple Carbs)... The front bumper chrome is peeling around bumper horns. There was never a heater installed which has kept the floor boards intact (most problems in these areas of this vintage were caused by leaking heaters). The car was kept by the original owner for 50 plus years in a garage which kept interior intact although there are some signs of aging on instruments. It was then sold to a collector and then to me. I have had it for 15 years always garaged kept. Tires are good as well as the spare. Engine runs great with no smoking or signs of excessive wear. It also has the hard to find rear fender skirts. Trunk is original with jack and spare tire."


Sold at a Car Auction
