1927 Oldsmobile Model 30 Series E Coachwork by Holden, Lot 314, Sold for \$28,600

"The Oldsmobile Sixes had commenced in 1923 with the first of the Model 30 series, which for the next few years would be powered by a 169ci (2,770cc) engine producing 42bhp. For 1927, the last year of the Model 30, the engine was enlarged to 185ci (3.0-litres) and four-wheel brakes adopted on these Series E cars... This right-hand drive **Oldsmobile Model 30 Series E** was shipped new to Australia and bodied there by Holden, later to become General Motors' subsidiary 'down under'. Restored circa 2000..."

COVER VEHICLE FEATURE ARTICLE

1948 Willys Overland "Jeep" CJ–2A

Owners: Bill & JoAnn Pyle Florida Region members

- 1) The Pyle's bought this Jeep's frame in Palatka, Florida in 2008 and added a reproduction Jeep body tub, fenders and hood. Bill already had the Jeep drivetrain and grille. 1945 was the first year for the Civilian Jeeps ("CJ"). About 214,760 CJ–2A's were made between 1945 and 1949.
- 2) This 134 cubic inch (2.2 liter) inline "Go–Devil" L–head four cylinder engine develops 60 horsepower at 4,000 rpms with torque of 105 at 2,000 rpms. Bill upgraded to 12 volt wiring and added a modern 12 volt alternator. The rest of the engine compartment is stock.
- 3) The 3 speed manual transmission shifter is floor mounted next to the controls for the four wheel drive system. The interior seats are tan vinyl with a desirable optional rear bench seat. The black vinyl top is new.
- 4) Secure storage on this Jeep is located under the passenger seat in this lockable cubby. Since all the metal body parts were replaced, Bill says there is no rust in this 66 year old Jeep. Ground clearance is 8 5/8 inches.
- 5) Bill has owned/restored 8 Willys vehicles. Tires are "Military" 6.0 16 bias ply. Wheelbase is 80 inches with a total weight of 2,137 pounds. I drove the car around and found the clutch a little stiff but the acceleration, steering and brakes were great. Top speed is reportedly 65 mph. Bill says the Jeep is fun to drive both in the backwoods and around town on clear sunny days.








