Board and General Meeting –

The Florida Region AACA Club general was held on February 10 at All Saints Church in

the Mary Martha Parlour. Fifteen members attended the general meeting after the board meeting.

President Charlie Jones called the meeting to order at 7 PM. The minutes from the December meeting as presented in the TRB newsletter were accepted by the club. The Treasury report for January was presented by Treasurer Don Allen and was accepted by the club members. The income from the Winter Classic show did not cover the cost of the show. So Don made a motion that the club operating account provide funds to make up the money lost at the Winter classic in the car show account. In the past two shows the car show profits were passed to the operating account. Since there is loss for this year's show, Don's motion allows the operating account to pass funds to the show account so the show account maintains the \$2000 balance it had before the show. The motion was accepted by the club.
